## NATIONAL SUPPLEMENT Between U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT and AMERICAN FEDERATION OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES NATIONAL COUNCIL OF HUD LOCALS 222

**Subject:** Reorganization of the Office of Administration

**Scope:** The scope of this Supplement encompasses the impact and implementation on bargaining unit employees of the realignment of the Office of Administration to conform with the Department's business processes.

- 1. <u>Position Descriptions and Performance Standards:</u> Management agrees that new position descriptions and elements and standards will be provided and communicated to all bargaining unit employees within 30 days of their reassignment.
- 2. <u>Local Bargaining:</u> Management agrees that, in accordance with Article 5. mid-term bargaining will be conducted at the local level concerning local issues related to the impact/implementation of the realignment of the Office of Administration, including physical moves/space changes.
- 3. <u>Training:</u> Management agrees, within budgetary limits, to provide appropriate training for reassigned employees.
- 4. <u>Bargaining Unit Status:</u> Management agrees that no existing positions will be taken out of the bargaining unit based solely on the fact that the realignment has taken place.
- 5. <u>Implementation Review:</u> Management agrees that the Office of Administration will conduct an incremental In-Process-Review with Union participation to review the realignment progress.
- 6. <u>Opportunities for Lower-Graded Employees:</u> Management agrees, where appropriate, to advertise positions at multiple grade levels in order to provide opportunities for lower-graded staff as a result of the realignment of the Office of Administration.
- 7. <u>Contracting Out Procedures:</u> Management agrees that no functions will be contracted out as a result of this realignment.

- 8. <u>Maximum Career Ladder Grade:</u> Management agrees that there will be no adverse impact on employees' career ladder promotions as a result of the implementation of this realignment.
- 9. <u>No Involuntary Geographic Moves:</u> Management agrees that no employee will be involuntarily relocated as a result of the Office of Administration realignment.
- 10. <u>No Employee Downgrades:</u> Management agrees that no employee will be downgraded as a result of the Office of Administration realignment.
- 11. <u>Administrative Support:</u> Management agrees that all HUD Field Offices will be supported by Administrative and Personnel Specialists.
- 12. <u>Employee Notification</u>: Management agrees, upon implementation of the realignment, to maintain a roster of key administrative contacts for Headquarters and the Field with their phone numbers on the HUDWEB.
- 13. <u>Employee Assistance Program:</u> Management agrees that the Employee Assistance Program and Staff will maintain its current reporting relationship and physical proximity to the Director of Human Resources.
