Is HUD complying with the FLSA Settlement?

AFGE Council 222 believes that the agency is failing to comply fully with the FLSA Settlement Agreement dated March 5, 2008. We are preparing for an arbitration hearing scheduled for September 11 and 12 and are gathering statements from witnesses and evidence to support our case.

We are looking for employees that, since March 5, 2008, have:

- received compensatory time without being given a choice to earn overtime pay;
- been asked, allowed, or expected to work "off the clock" (i.e. through lunch, before/after work, or weekends) without pay; or
- traveled during a time that they were entitled to overtime pay, but did not receive a choice of overtime pay
