




**Subject: Travel Bonuses received on Official Travel**

This Supplement, entered into this 30<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2002, evidences the parties' intent to facilitate smooth implementation of Section 1116 of law S. 1438 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2002, signed into law on December 28, 2001.

As set forth in Federal Travel Advisory Number 5, dated December 31, 2001, Federal employees are authorized to retain promotional items, including frequent flyer miles, earned on official travel. The HUD/AFGE Agreement at Section 25.13 is changed to read in its entirety:

Section 25.13 – Travel Bonuses. In accordance with law, Frequent Flyer Bonuses, awards, and promotional materials received by employees as a result of official travel belong to the employee.
